MOSCOW HOSTS CONGRESS FROM APRIL 23RD THROUGH APRIL 29TH

With over 100 delegates from Greece, Germany, Sweden, Finland, Spain, Portugal, Bulgaria, the United States and many parts of Russia, the 17th Annual INEPS Congress proved to be a great success. The Welcoming Dinner held at the Productive School "Khamovniki" was prepared by the students and proved to be a culinary delight with all sorts of Russian dishes to sample.

The Opening sessions and subsequent workshops on Sunday and Monday were held at the Academy of Teachers/Educators Professional Development and Retraining. Although the weather was cold and rainy to be gin with the atmosphere in the hall was warm and cordial. The theme of the Congress was Productive Learning and School Democratization.

On Tuesday the delegates broke up into groups and visited various schools in Moscow for a first hand look at education in Russia. The following schools were visited:
