## THE EUROPEAN MOQUAVO-CONGRESS SUPPORTS THE POTENTIAL OF CIVIC ENGAGEMENT IN DRUG ADDICTION PREVENTION

The European Congress "Motivation and Qualification of Volunteers" (MoQuaYo) took place on October, the 22nd /23rd at the Centre Culturel de Rencontre in Luxembourg. About 120 participants represented 16 countries participated. The congress was the completion of a successful European project, which aimed at the enhancement of the conditions for volunteers' in terms of motivation and qualifications in Europe and on proclaiming the relevance of volunteerism for addiction prevention. In this project nine organizations from seven European countries worked together in an interdisciplinary manner. "PROTASI" in Patras - Greece is actively involved in this project. The project was coordinated by the Centre de Prévention des Toxicomanies (CePT) in Luxembourg and supported by the European Commission.

Lectures with renowned experts of voluntary work and addiction prevention inspired the congress participants. Interactive workshops afforded the opportunity to deal actively with concrete aspects of volunteerism. The congress was enriched by the theatre group "Wilde Bühne" from Stuttgart (Germany).

In summary it was found that the motives and needs of volunteers have changed during the last decades. The personal benefit as well as the possibilities to gain new competencies and skills gain in importance. As a result, new demands for the organization and design of voluntary work have arisen.

Furthermore it can be stated that the engagement of volunteers is achieving increasing importance for the modern civil society. Volunteers enable a diversified network of preventive activities in all areas of public and private life. Their closeness to the target group builds a bridge between professional aid and every day help.

The knowledge from practice and science has been accumulated and a manual including concrete guidelines and strategies has been worked out, which was presented at the congress. The manual which is more than 300 pages can be ordered at the CePT at a price of 55,- €. Beside the main topics of motivation and qualification the manual includes a charter for voluntary engagement in drug addiction prevention, evaluation tool and various basic information about volunteerism in the field of addiction prevention.
