THE EUROPLE SEMINARS

INEPS is struggling for a better quality in our educational systems through the dissemination of the philosophy, the methodology and the practices of Productive Learning. The further aim is a better future for young people and educators. According to this general statement some members of INEPS from Finland, Germany, Greece, Madeira, France, Cyprus and Hungary took the initiative to apply to the EU for a SOCRATES-COMENIUS II project with the title EUROPLE (European Productive Learning Educators) which would allow them to organize training courses for educators, teachers, facilitators, animators, youth, social workers and all those who are interested in Productive Learning and interactive educational methods all over Europe. The EU accepted the application and the above EUROPLE team came to an agreement which is summarized into the following:

There will be offered a) three seminars for the above mentioned target group from experienced INEPS members who work in Institutions and Organizations as educators for adults and students and b) material based on Educational Methods for the implementation of PL and alternative education.

The three seminars will take place:

- 1. Topic: EUROPLE- EUROPEAN PRODUCTIVE LEARNING IN NON- FORMAL EDUCATION**
in Patras-the cultural capital of Europe for 2006-GREECE from 6 to 10 November 2006
- 2. Topic: PRODUCTIVE LEARNING IN GENERAL EDUCATION**
in Berlin-the metropolis of PL in Europe-GERMANY from 15 to 19 January 2007
- 3. Topic: PRODUCTIVE LEARNING IN VOCATIONAL EDUCATION**
in Tampere - one of the cities of Finland which occupies the 1st place
at PIZA chart-FINLAND from 26 to 30 March 2007

The three seminars will consist of a maximum of 30 persons each, from different European countries (the hosting country is excluded according to EU rules) and the language in all seminars will be in English.

We invite you to apply to your national agencies in order to get the funding yourselves to attend these seminars. It's up to you to decide which of the three seminars better fits your needs. You can look for further information from your national agencies in your own language.
