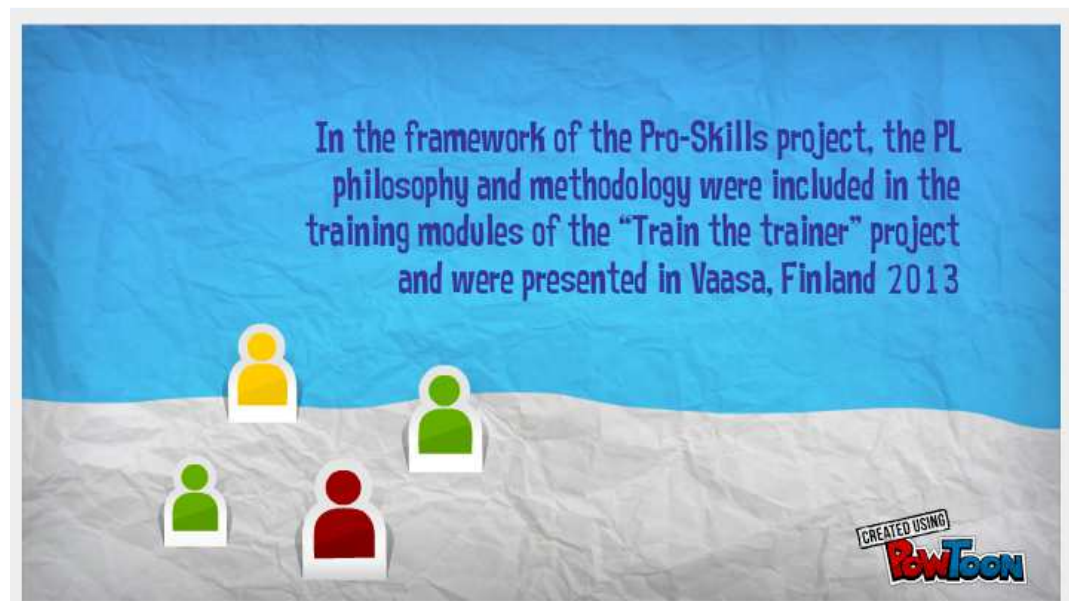



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CAS was nominated and recognized as Apple Distinguished School for use of technology in the school and at the internship sites

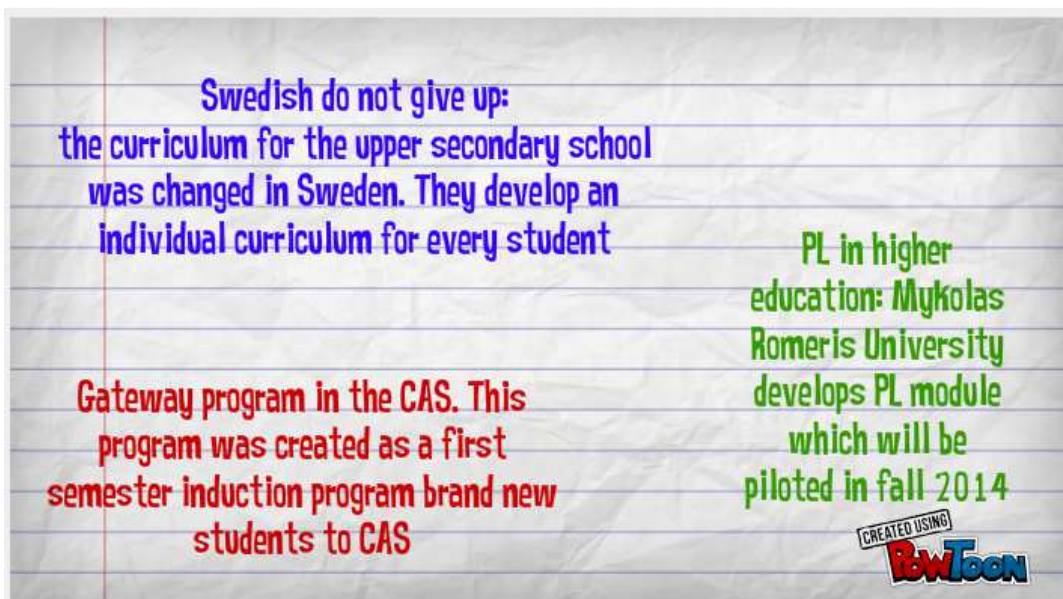
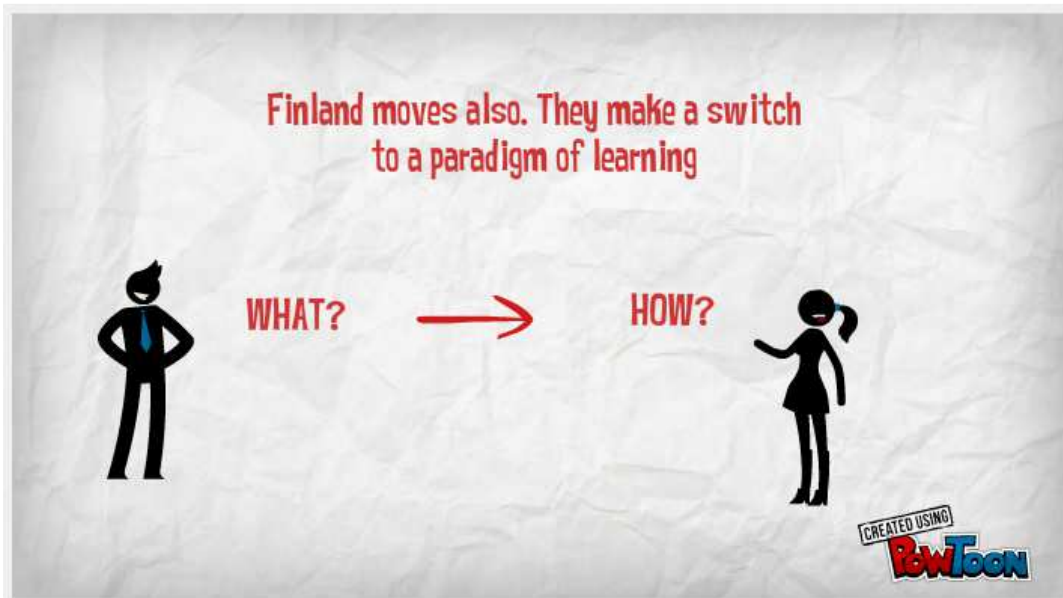
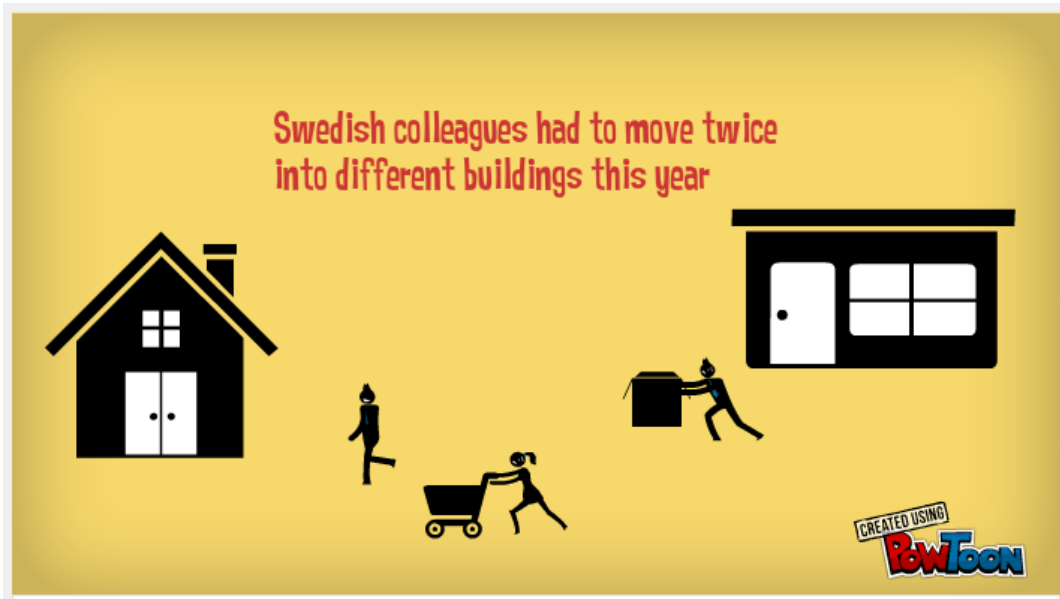


The team of the international Early School-leaving and Second-chance Project introduced the Alternative Education Project and PL as one of the best practice in Lithuania for reducing early school leaving
